RECORDERS ON APPROVAL

The approval period is nominally ten days.

Please ensure that instruments are not marked or damaged in any way if they are to be returned. In particular, do not allow teeth to come into contact with the beak, do not poke fingers into the voicing window and do not mark the thumbhole by using pressure from your nail. Those who wear rings should take particular care not to scratch or bruise the recorder when putting it together, or taking it apart. Lipstick is forbidden.

Observe normal practice for new instruments and do not play for long periods. Do not attempt to "play in" an instrument on approval. When wet, the recorder should be sucked to clear it. After use it should be mopped dry and returned to its case after about twenty minutes.

Do not oil the instrument or grease the corks. Any grease necessary will have been applied, sufficient for the trial.

All leaflets, accessories, and packaging, specific to an instrument must be returned with it. A charge may be made for missing items, or damage to an instrument.

The insurance arranged by Saunders Recorders extends up to the point of delivery.

When making payment, please take care to do the right sum. Subtract the cost of the returned items from the total. It is all too easy to miss something if you add up the cost of retained items. All delivery charges must be settled, even if all the instruments are returned.
